In recognizing that the Anishinaabemowin language and culture are gateways towards strengthening our students, school and community, the Netamisakomik Centre for Education is seeking applications for a part-time Native Language Teacher.

Reporting to the Principal, the Native Language Teacher will be responsible for developing an effective Ojibway language learning environments for students with a focus on their cultural and educational backgrounds, experiences with different learning modalities; incorporate various methods of instruction, assessment and evaluation; employ the use of technology to support the learning environment; maintain effective classroom routines as well as excellent classroom management skills; effective curriculum planning; daily lesson planning; excellent communication skills and enthusiasm.

The Native Language Teacher will facilitate the learning of the Anishinaabemowin language and culture, and encourage students to strive for success. This position will model and espouse the Seven Teachings of love respect, wisdom, humility, bravery, honesty and truth while following the policy and procedures of Pic Mobert First Nation.

As Educational Assistant you will assist in the classroom under the direction of the teacher and also assist the Numeracy/Literacy Coordinator with the First Nation's Student Success Program.

Applicants should be fluent in Ojibway, hold Native Language instruction certification, and/or Ontario College of Teachers certification. As this position works with young people, individuals must complete a health assessment including drug testing prior to employment and may be subject to random drug testing during employment.
